

Mutual recognition of fertilisers

ÚKSÚP requirements for annexes to the application for mutual recognition of fertilisers ON MUTUAL RECOGNITION AND INCLUSION OF A PRODUCT IN THE LIST OF MUTUALLY RECOGNIZED FERTILIZERS

- 1) Safety Data Sheet (SDS) – in Slovak, if the product is classified as hazardous according to Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH).
- 2) For fertilisers based on ammonium nitrate with more than 28% nitrogen content, a test report on resistance to detonation is required according to Regulation (EC) No. 2003/2003.
- 3) Certified copy of the document proving legal placement of the product on the market in another EU Member State (e.g. registration, certificate, declaration by a competent authority, etc.).
- 4) Official Slovak translation of the above document (not required if the document is in Czech).
- 5) Original label or leaflet used in the original registration.
- 6) Laboratory analysis results of risk elements and substances as submitted in the Member State.
- 7) Label or leaflet in Slovak language in accordance with ÚKSÚP's requirements.

ÚKSÚP requirements for annexes to the application for mutual recognition of fertilisers APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT/EXTENSION OF REGISTRATION OF MUTUALLY RECOGNIZED FERTILIZER
